Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1800 UTC Monday 01 November to 1800 UTC Tuesday 02 November 2021

#### General Situation

A low centred close to the northern isles will move away northwards and fill, allowing winds to continue easing across the British Isles. A slacker but colder northerly flow will then become established by Wednesday.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in south, veering northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Moderate or rough, but slight or moderate in Moray Firth.

Showers, perhaps thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming very rough later in far northwest.

Showers.

Good.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, veering west 4 or 5, then veering northwest later.

Rough at first near Rattray Head, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first, veering north 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough later near Rattray Head.

Showers.

Good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, veering northwest 3 or 4 later.

Moderate becoming slight, occasionally smooth later.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first, veering north 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate, occasionally rough later offshore.

Showers.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4.

Moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 3 or 4, veering northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.

Showers.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 to 6, veering westerly 3 or 4, occasionally 2 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth later except in far northeast.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 2 or 3, veering northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later in north.

Fair at first, then showers.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 or 6, veering northwesterly 3 or 4, then becoming variable 1 to 3 later.

Moderate becoming slight, occasionally smooth later in east.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming north or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, fair later in west.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West 4 or 5, veering northwest 3 or 4, then becoming variable 1 to 3 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming north 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers at first.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first and later near Isles of Scilly.

Slight or moderate, but moderate or rough west of Lizard Point.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 in west, occasionally 5 later in east.

Slight or moderate, but moderate or rough near Isles of Scilly.

Showers, mainly in west.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 2 to 4, then north later.

Moderate or rough in west, slight or moderate in east.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 in west, occasionally 7 later in far west.

Slight in east, moderate in west.

Showers, mainly in west.

Good, occasionally moderate in west.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming northerly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later in exposed west.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Moderate becoming slight, occasionally smooth later.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming north 4 or 5, then veering northeast 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate in south and west.

Showers, fair later.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, veering northwest 3 or 4 later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Showers.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

West 5 or 6, veering northwest 4 or 5, then veering north 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough in west, slight or moderate in east.

Showers.

Northerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in west.

Moderate or rough in west, slight or moderate in east.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5, then veering north 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will track north through Shetland Waters on Monday with northwesterly flow developing on Tuesday.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first in the south of the area, veering northwesterly 3 to 5 for a time tonight, becoming variable 1 to 3 by dawn, but gusty near showers.

Slight to moderate, locally rather rough early this evening, decreasing mainly smooth by dawn, with a low to moderate swell.

Showers, locally heavy, with a risk of hail and thunder.

Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 1 to 3, but gusty near showers, becoming north 3 to 4 by mid morning.

Smooth or slight with a low swell.

Showers, locally heavy, with a risk of hail and thunder.
