Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Heavy rain and strong winds will slowly clear eastwards from England and Wales on Sunday, although the far southeast of England is likely to stay wet into the early evening. Much brighter conditions with sunny or clear spells will follow the rain, although showers will continue to affect northern Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday is expected to start dry and bright with some sunshine for most areas but cloud and outbreaks of rain will arrive across western parts of the UK later. Further cloud and rain, with locally strong winds, is expected for most parts on Tuesday.
