Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud and outbreaks of rain over southern Britain will spread northwards to affect the rest of England and Wales, as well as southern Scotland and Northern Ireland today. Some of the rain will be heavy and prolonged. This rain will clear much of England and Wales overnight but will continue across Scotland and Northern Ireland. Becoming windy.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Heavy rain will linger over Scotland and Northern Ireland during much of Sunday, showers elsewhere mostly clearing away to the east with some good sunny spells. On Monday, some showers in northwest Britain, otherwise generally fine and sunny. Breezy at first.
