Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Rain will spread into southwest England during the morning, then spread northeast into parts of Wales, central and southern England. Some of the rain will be heavy. The rain may reach southeast England during the evening. Further north it will be generally brighter, though some eastern parts of England and southern Scotland will remain cloudier with showers. Temperatures below normal, cool in the northeast.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain in parts of the south Monday morning will clear, with drier, sunnier conditions spreading from the north. Most areas dry on Tuesday, with good sunny spells in many places and temperatures recovering to near normal.
