Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Dry but bitterly cold to start across much of England and Wales. Across northwestern areas, it will be windy with heavy rain turning to snow in places, particularly over higher ground. Strong winds, rain and hill snow will gradually push southeastwards, reaching the far south east by evening and with wintry showers following in places. Remaining cold.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Drier on Friday with some brightness but with showers in places, particularly towards the east. Staying cold and windy with showers wintry over higher ground. Largely fine on Saturday with sunny spells and lighter winds, but staying cold with patchy rain across Scotland.
