Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
A bright start for many but showers, already over northern parts, will develop quite widely, falling as sleet and snow over northern mountains. In between the showers some bright or sunny spells are expected, and southwestern parts should remain generally dry. Brisk winds for many, locally strong across the north, making it feel chilly.

Becoming dry and chilly for most with frost in places. Some rain, sleet and snow showers affecting northern and eastern Scotland and northeast England.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Some showers in eastern parts on Tuesday but many other places dry. Wind and rain affecting Scotland on Wednesday but fine elsewhere.
