Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of snow across southern Scotland dying during the morning, then for most, a dry day with some sunshine after a frosty, icy start. However, heavy rain and strong easterly winds will edge northwards into southern England and later south Wales, turning to sleet or snow away from the far south later. Remaining cold.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Heavy rain, sleet or snow across central and southern areas Monday night with some heavy snowfall possible away from the far south, accompanied by northerly gales, clearing away southeastwards Tuesday. Thereafter, sunny spells by day and frosty nights, just a few wintry showers in places.
