

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Tuesday 22 Jan 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A cold, frosty start with a risk of ice on untreated surfaces. Dry with some sunshine in most places at first but with cloud and occasional rain spreading to northern, western and later some central areas. Tonight, cloudy with occasional drizzly rain, most of this in the northwest, that in the south light and intermittent, eastern parts staying mainly dry.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Cloudy, mild and breezy, occasional mainly light rain and drizzle chiefly western coasts and hills. Some brighter spells possible in east. Becoming colder and clearer in northwest later with wintry showers. Much colder Thursday with sunny spells and wintry showers.
