

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Persistent and occasionally heavy rain will affect southern and south-eastern England and Wales, where it will also be significantly cooler than recent days. There will be a brisk breeze around south-eastern coasts too, whilst elsewhere there will be a mixture of sunshine and showers across Scotland and Northern Ireland. These will fade this evening and it will turn chilly.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday and Friday will see sunshine and showers, these becoming mostly confined to the south into Friday with more in the way of sunshine further north. Winds will be light so it will feel pleasantly warm by day, but chilly overnight.
