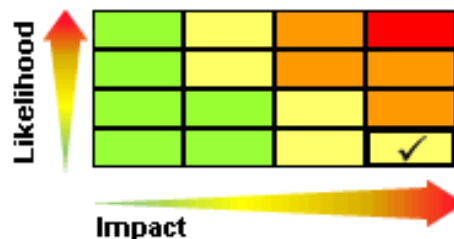
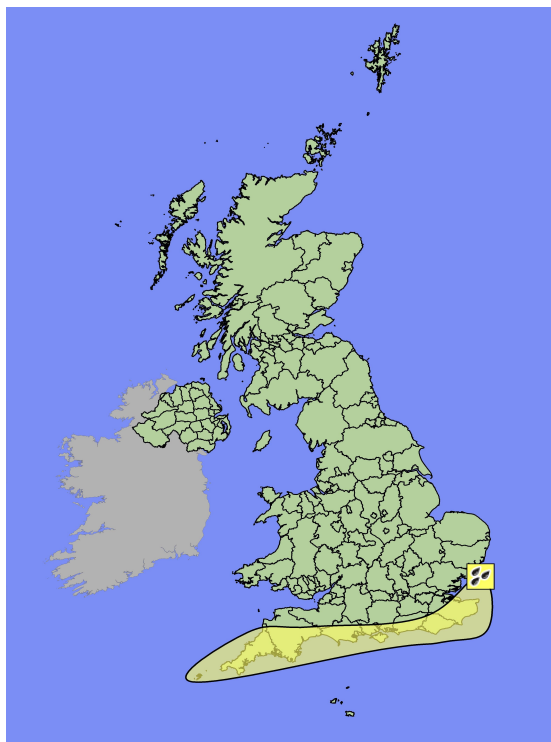




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

A developing area of low pressure will move eastwards through the English Channel during Thursday night, bringing heavy rain to southern counties of England. 15-25 mm is expected to fall widely with as much as 40 mm over parts of south Cornwall and south Devon.

There remains a low risk that the low pressure centre could track a little further north, which would bring a risk of gusts of 70 mph to southeast England. Please keep up to date with all warnings and weather forecasts.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **20:00 on Thu, 15th Dec 2011** until **09:00 on Fri, 16th Dec 2011**

An area of heavy rain is expected to move quickly eastwards across southern counties of England during Thursday evening and during the first part of Friday. The rain will be accompanied by fresh to strong winds with a low risk of gales or severe gales near coasts in the far southeast early on Friday.

The public is advised to be aware of the risk of localised flooding due to rain falling onto already saturated ground.
