Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Patchy drizzle will become confined to northwestern regions by
afternoon. For many, Tuesday will be dry and, although rather cloudy
for many areas, some bright or sunny spells are also expected, the
best of these, perhaps, in eastern parts of Scotland and England and
south of any high ground elsewhere. It will be generally mild again,
especially in the brighter, sheltered areas, although eastern regions
may start rather chilly. Breezy in the north.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
The north, often cloudy and windy with rain or showers. Further
south, mainly dry but generally cloudy, best bright spells in the
east. Mostly mild.
