REMARKS.

Barometers are unsteady in the north, and are much higher in the south of the British Isles than in the north of Scotland. On our northern coasts temperatures have declined. The winds this morning are chiefly westerly and moderate, but at places on our eastern and western coasts they are strong. At Cape Clear the sea is high. Barometric pressure ^{yesterday} was high in the northeast and southwest of Europe and comparatively low over the Black Sea and Scotland; temperature had declined in Russia, and at St Petersburg at Sam the thermometer stood at -34° Fah.

Barometrical pressure yesterday was low in the north of Europe, increasing in a southerly direction to about 30.4 inches over the Mediterranean.
