#### General Situation

Areas of low pressure will continue to affect the United Kingdom bringing rain or showers to all areas.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4, becoming southeasterly 4 or 5 in northeast. Mainly smooth at first in Moray Firth, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4 or 5 at first in northeast and southerly 4 or 5 later near Cape Wrath, otherwise variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth in Moray Firth.

Moderate at first near North Foreland, otherwise smooth or slight.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.

Rain or showers in east.

Good, occasionally moderate at first in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Showers at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming west or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

Variable 3 or 4, becoming west 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times later.

Moderate in far west, otherwise slight.

West or southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 at times.

Moderate in far west, otherwise mainly slight.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

#### Shetland Isles

General Situation  
Complex area of low pressure is centred southeast of Iceland with a second centre east of Shetland on Saturday. A slow moving frontal wave sits to the east of Shetland on Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue

Northwesterly 4 or 5 at first in west, otherwise variable 3 becoming southerly

or southeasterly 4 or 5.  
Moderate.  
Rain soon clearing.  
Good, occasionally moderate or poor at first.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Sunday 06 Jul until 1800 UTC on Sunday 06 Jul:

Southeast 4 or 5.  
Moderate, becoming slight later east of Shetland.  
Fair.  
Good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southwest to west 3 to 4, locally 5 in the southeast of the area this evening, veering northwest overnight, backing westerly increasing west 4 to 5 Sunday afternoon.

Slight to moderate.

Rain and drizzle, locally heavy, clearing during the evening isolated showers by morning.

Moderate to poor, becoming good this evening, locally moderate in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 to 5, decreasing 3 to 4 in the morning.

Slight, locally moderate at first, with a low swell.

Isolated showers.

Good, locally moderate in showers.

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
