Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Most places starting dry. Misty low cloud across southern areas will lift, then many areas should have some warm sunshine and isolated light showers for a time. More prolonged rain, already across the far west will edge eastwards during the day, but southeast England should remain dry, and drier, brighter conditions should reach the southwest later.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will be breezy with sunshine and showers, these merging into longer spells of rain across western Scotland. More prolonged rain and strong winds will spread northeastwards to most places on Wednesday, to be followed by sunshine and blustery showers. Temperatures near average.
