Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Most parts of the UK will see a dry day with variable cloud and sunny spells.
Winds will be generally light east to south-easterly and it will feel warm or very warm. A risk of a few scattered showers across Northern Ireland and later south-west England.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Showers in the south-west will push north-east through the day on Friday with more persistent rain following into the south-west, and then this also spreading north-east. Locally heavy rain in the north on Saturday with sunny spells and scattered showers following from the south-west, some heavy and thundery. Still warm or very warm.
