



# National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

The track and final depth of the developing low pressure centre, which could lead to the strong winds, rain and snow, is at this stage very uncertain. It may be that the system reaches its peak intensity well to the east of the UK, in which case impacts on UK weather would be rather less.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Alert of Wind**

Valid from **12:00 on Thu, 08th Dec 2011** until **12:00 on Fri, 09th Dec 2011**

Winds will increase during Thursday afternoon and evening and gusts of 60 to 70 mph could become quite widespread across Scotland, with 80 mph gusts possible over exposed coasts and hills.

Heavy rain and hill snow are likely to accompany the strengthening winds but detail this far ahead is impossible to pin down.
