Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be a largely dry start with mist clearing and sunny spells developing. Many parts will enjoy a fine day with warm sunshine but patchy rain will affect Northern Ireland, and rain and stronger winds will affect eastern parts by evening. This rain will edge further west overnight, reaching central areas by dawn. Dry and clear elsewhere.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday will see locally heavy rain continue to affect central and eastern areas with patchy rain across the far west. Dry elsewhere with warm sunshine. The rain will ease on Friday with sunny spells and scattered showers, heavy in places.
