Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Rain, heavy in places with gusty winds, will clear eastwards across most parts this morning, though not clearing the far southeast of England until early afternoon. Good sunny spells will develop behind the rain, although cloud and showers will affect coasts and hills in the northwest. Windy, with gales in places and feeling chilly.

Tonight, western coasts and hills will have blustery showers but elsewhere it should be mostly dry. Staying windy in the west.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will be windy with blustery showers and sunny spells. Further showers in many places Wednesday, although the far south should stay mainly dry.
