

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many places dry with plenty of warm sunshine and light winds, the exception being western Scotland which will start rather cloudy with further outbreaks of rain. Also, isolated showers may later develop across parts of England, but many places staying dry. Most of the UK continuing dry and increasingly clear overnight.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Fine and dry for many places during Tuesday morning, although scattered heavy showers in the west will gradually move northeastwards during the late afternoon and evening. On Wednesday, the occasional rain or heavy showers will continue clearing northeastwards, with brighter and drier conditions following in the west.
