

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 1945 on Saturday 10 Feb 2018

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
It will feel very cold everywhere tomorrow in brisk northwesterly winds. The windchill factor will make it feel below freezing all day even though thermometers will mostly rise above zero. Frequent sleet and snow showers in the west will spread eastwards later. Slight accumulations of snow are possible anywhere but large accumulations are only likely on northwestern hills.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday will be very similar to Sunday with sunshine, more wintry showers and a chilly wind. Early on Tuesday a squally band of persistent rain and hill snow will pass through, followed by more wintry showers later in the day.
