Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy, blustery showers over Scotland and Northern Ireland, falling as snow on hills. Showers will also develop elsewhere, some heavy over northern England, easing during the afternoon and largely dying out by evening. Windy, with gales across northern Scotland. Good spells of sunshine between the showers.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Continuing windy with rain and drizzle over Scotland and Northern Ireland, slowly clearing during Sunday. Most other places dry and sunny on Saturday, though cloud increasing over the west. Rain reaching Wales, northern and western England on Sunday. Strong winds on Saturday, winds easing on Sunday.
