Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
An area of rain and snow lying from southwest England to eastern England will drift southeast and become lighter and patchy. To the north the weather will be drier with a few bright spells but there may be some rain in northern Scotland. Southeast England should be mostly dry but very cold after a sharp frost.  
Tonight patchy rain or sleet in the southeast otherwise dry with fog patches and a few pockets of frost.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Rain spreading to the north and west on Sunday, drier in the southeast. Showers and longer spells of rain for Monday.
