Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Rain, heavy at times, spreading southeast across Scotland and Northern Ireland today, clearing through overnight, followed by showers in the far north. Early cloud breaking over England and Wales before increasingly patchy rain moves southeast overnight. Winds strengthening in north, gales far northwest for a time, decreasing overnight.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Sunday, Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England dry with plenty of sunshine. Cloud and rain clearing Wales, the Midlands and East Anglia, but dull and drizzly over the south. Monday, England and Wales dry with sunny spells after early cloud clears the southeast. Cloud and wind increasing over Scotland and Northern Ireland.
