Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Dry across England and Wales with lots of sunshine at first, and although it becomes cloudier during the day, there will still be some sunny periods.
Cloudier in Scotland and Northern Ireland with showers or longer spells of rain, which will be heavy at times. Most places stay dry overnight, although rain continues in northern and western parts.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Showery rain affects western parts on Sunday, with the east staying largely dry with some sunshine. Rain is expected to spread across the UK from the west on Monday, although some parts of the east will have a dry and bright start.
