


 **Yellow warning**
Rain

Between
18:00 Mon 23 Mar 2020 and
12:00 Wed 25 Mar 2020



Heavy persistent rain may lead to impacts from flooding.

What to expect

- Flooding of a few homes and businesses is likely
- Bus services probably affected with journey times taking longer
- Spray and flooding on roads probably making journey times longer
- Some interruption to power supplies and other services is possible

Further details

Rain will become heavy at times later on Monday and is likely to persist through Tuesday and the first part of Wednesday. Through the whole period 50-75 mm of rain is likely quite widely, with 100-125 mm possible in places, mainly on higher ground. Very strong southerly winds will be an additional hazard
