Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be dry across much of the UK with warm sunny spells, especially in the south and east. However, winds will strengthen in the west, associated with a band of rain already across western Scotland and Northern Ireland. This rain will gradually move eastwards, reaching central and eastern areas by dawn, with cooler, clearer conditions following.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain will clear to the southeast of England during Saturday with brighter weather for a time. However, another band of rain will spread in from the northwest later, clearing to cooler, more showery weather on Sunday afternoon. It will stay breezy throughout.
