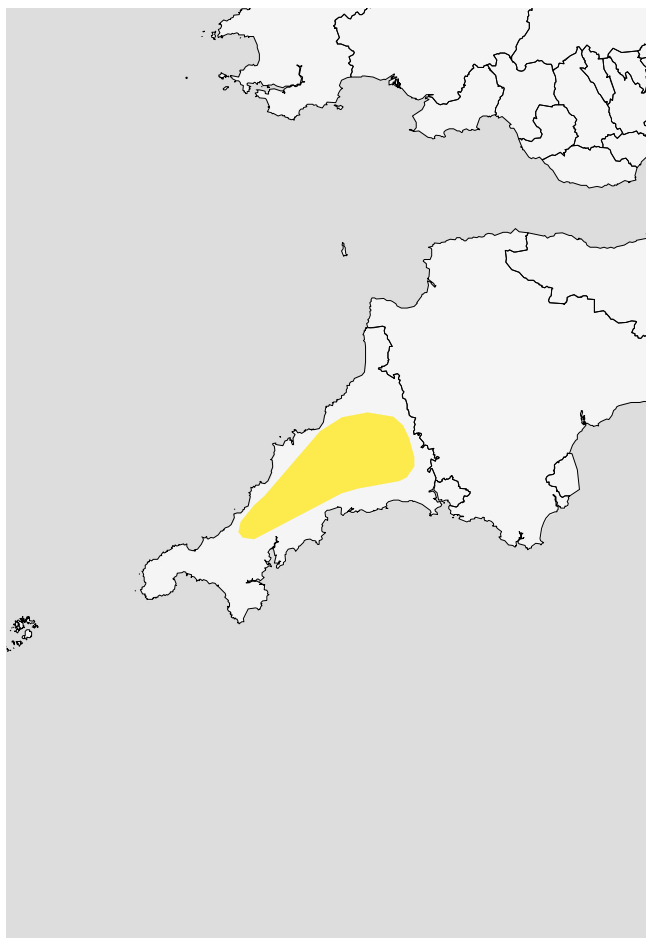




## Yellow warning Rain

Between  
**04:00 Wed 20 Nov 2019** and  
**11:00 Wed 20 Nov 2019**



## Heavy rain during Wednesday morning likely bringing some travel disruption to parts of Cornwall.

### What to expect

- Spray and flooding on roads probably making journey times longer
- Bus and train services probably affected with journey times taking longer

### Further details

An area of rain will persist over parts of Cornwall during Wednesday morning before easing by the afternoon.

Whilst much of Cornwall will see relatively small rainfall amounts some areas, particularly the high ground of Bodmin moor, may see 20-30 mm of rain, much of this falling in 6 hours during the busy morning travel period.
