

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 1945 on Monday 07 Jan 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Many northern parts will be chilly but dry at first, but cloudy conditions with outbreaks of rain elsewhere will gradually spread northeastwards across most parts during the day. Heavy and persistent rain is likely in places, especially across Wales, with a risk of some snow over northern Britain. Windy, with gales developing around exposed coasts, making it feel chilly.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Plenty of fine, dry weather and sunny spells are likely on Wednesday, but there will also be some blustery showers at times. Cloudy, wet and windy weather is then expected on Thursday with some persistent, perhaps heavy, rain and southerly gales.
