Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A few light showers will drift onto some eastern UK coasts, and also across the far north of Scotland. Otherwise today will be dry, with long sunny spells for most places, once early patchy fog and frost clear. Generally rather cold. Overnight cloud will increase across the far north of Scotland to bring light rain. Elsewhere dry, frosty and foggy.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday occasional light rain across the far north of Scotland, otherwise dry but with fog persisting in many places. Sunny where the fog clears. Monday a band of rain will move south, cold weather following with scattered wintry coastal showers.
