Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain across central and eastern areas, with snow over Scottish mountains will clear away eastwards. Much brighter weather with sunny spells and scattered showers in the west will then spread to most places by afternoon. Despite being less mild, it should still feel pleasant out of doors in sunshine and in generally light winds.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Overnight rain Saturday night will clear eastwards during Sunday to leave sunny spells and wintry showers, these mainly in the west. A widespread frost Sunday night with Monday another day of sunny spells and scattered wintry showers. It will be generally cold.
