Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Many areas will be dry with sunny spells today. However, showers will affect eastern England and eastern Scotland, with a few lighter showers across Northern Ireland, west Wales and Cornwall. Feeling less cold, although windy in the southeast initially. Mostly dry overnight. Turning frosty under clear spells, with fog forming.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Frost and fog will lift to leave a mostly fine start tomorrow. However, wet and locally windy weather will spread eastwards across Britain, giving some snow in the north. Remaining generally unsettled midweek with showers or longer spells of rain, and some hill snow. Remaining chilly with brisk winds again.
