Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
After a widespread, sharp overnight frost, Tuesday should be another mostly dry, rather cold day with sunny periods. Overnight fog patches may be slow to clear in places especially around the Severn Valley area. A scattering of wintry showers are possible, mainly in the east where some accumulations are possible.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Snow showers will continue across eastern coastal areas throughout Wednesday, while there is a risk of some more persistent snow for southwestern areas early in the day. Thursday sees a band of snow spreading northeast across Wales and central and southern parts of England, with some significant falls possible.
