Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a cold start with a widespread frost, most areas will have a sunny but chilly day. There will be some locally wintry showers in eastern coastal districts today, and these will continue tonight. However, most places will be dry and a widespread sharp frost is expected, along with some mist and freezing fog, mainly in the west.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Most areas will stay dry with sunny spells, but there is a continuing risk of wintry showers in eastern counties. It will remain cold across the UK with widespread overnight frosts and freezing fog patches that may be slow to clear.
