Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Patchy rain moving to far north of Scotland, though Northern Isles should stay dry. Outbreaks of rain, some heavy, over southern England spreading to Wales, Northern Ireland, central and eastern England. Northern England and southern Scotland dry, a chance of sunshine in west. Eastern coastal counties of England remaining grey and misty. Windy and feeling cold in northeast.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday generally unsettled with outbreaks of rain or showers in most places, occasionally heavy. Western Scotland, Northern Ireland and southwest England should be drier. Thursday mostly dry, though mist and drizzle on northeast coasts. Rain later in west. Near average temperatures.
