Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Showers will affect northern Scotland on Monday, wintry over hills, becoming confined to the Northern Isles by the end of the day. Further south, rain will affect most other areas, turning to snow briefly across parts of Northern Ireland, northern England and southern Scotland; mainly over hills. It will be mild and windy towards the south.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Rain in the southwest will come back northeastwards Tuesday morning, temporarily turning to snow as it arrives over northern hills. It will remain cloudy and breezy as rain clears, with patchy drizzle. Further rain and gales are likely during Wednesday, with some brighter intervals.
