Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Frequent snow showers affecting much of northern and western Britain bringing further accumulations with some drifting, especially over higher ground. Elsewhere, mostly dry with long sunny then clear periods, though scattered snow showers developing over the west Midlands and central-southern England. Widespread overnight frost, locally severe. Cold or very cold.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Snow showers continuing to affect northern and some western parts, also across the Midlands for a time on Thursday while remaining parts dry and mainly sunny. Sunny spells and scattered snow showers over northern areas on Friday, cloudy over far southern England with a low risk of persistent, heavy snow.
