

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Wednesday 08 Aug 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A generally dry day with warm and sunny spells for most. However, mist may linger around some southern and western coasts. Southern Britain will be cloudier with some rain, clearing to isolated showers later. Showers will also affect northeastern Scotland. Overnight it will become dry across all parts. Low cloud and mist patches are expected to form quite widely again.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Mainly dry through Thursday and Friday with sunny spells. It will feel very warm in the sunshine, particularly across the south of the UK, but also humid. Overnight mist and fog patches may linger through the day around some coasts.
