Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A cloudy and increasingly windy day is expected with rain in the north and west spreading across other areas at times. Heaviest rain will be across Wales, western Scotland and northwest England especially through Sunday evening and night when there is a risk of localised flooding. It will become mild but with strengthening southerly winds.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Brighter, showery weather reaching northern and western areas Monday morning will spread southeastwards during the day, although the southeast may stay cloudy until evening. Further rain and strong winds will affect northern parts on Tuesday while central and southern areas stay dry.
