

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Friday 10 Dec 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Rather cloudy with patchy rain in some southwestern parts, drier elsewhere with increasing amounts of sunshine, especially in northern and eastern areas of the UK. Winds continue to ease but turn northerly, heralding a return to cold temperatures, with night frosts and freezing fog in places.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
During Sunday and Monday it will continue cold. Most areas will be largely dry and cloudy, however, northern and eastern parts are most likely to see rain or wintry showers, and perhaps hill snow. The risk of overnight widespread frosts, freezing fog and icy patches continues.
