Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most of Britain will be fine and dry, though it will begin cloudy and damp in the east this morning. After a bright start, it will turn wet across Northern Ireland, with heavy rain by the afternoon. Rain will gradually move away from Northern Ireland this evening and tonight to affect western Britain. Dry across central and eastern Britain tonight.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Predominantly cloudy on Thursday, with occasional rain in the west. Drier and somewhat brighter further east with isolated light showers. Rather wet across eastern England on Friday, but drier with isolated showers to the north and west.
