Book 1 (BAE01): Fair Meteorological Log Started February 27 1911 Cape Adare, Finished June 30<sup>th</sup> 1911, observers Frank Vernon Browning, Harry Dickason and Raymond Edward Priestley. Contains diagram of The carusophone or Gramophone Alarm at the front and Meteorological Album (short poem) at the back.

BAE14: 25 January 1911 – 25 May 1911 Hut Point etc. (15 miles South of Headquarters). Observer E. L. Atkinson

BAE16: Book 2 B.E.A. 1910 Eastern Party 1 July 1911 – 15 November 1911 Cape Adare B.A.E 1910

BAE17: Meteorological Record Rough Notes Cape Adare 27 February 1911 – 17 May 1911 R. W. Priestley. (note on front states 'to be left at Cape Adare unless the Fair Notes are lost').

BAE18: Meteology(sic) Fair Log No.3 16 November 1911 – 3 January 1912

BAE19: C.C. Cape Crozier Journey 27 June 1911 – 1 August 1911 Observer H. Bowers (lowest temperature experienced of -77.5 deg F)

BAE20: Captain Scott's journey to the Western Mountains 15 September 1911 – 28 September 1911. Observer G. Simpson

BAE21: E.R.G.R. Evans Depot Trip 9 September 1911 – 11 October 1911

BAE22: Hut Point 28 September 1911 – 1 May 1912

BAE23: Hut Point 26 September – 1 November 1912

BAE24: Western Party 16 November 1911 – 15 February 1912, observer I C.S. Wright in 1911 – 1<sup>st</sup> West Exped, observer II Griffith Taylor – Discovery Hut (Mar) and observer III Griffith Taylor 1911 to 1912 – 2<sup>nd</sup> West Exped (Nov to Feb).

BAE25: Copy of Polar Log 1 November 1911 – 11 March 1912. Fair copy held with Scott Polar Institute

BAE26: Register of Motor Party 27 October 1911 – 20 December 1911

BAE27: Register of Dog Sledge Party 4 November 1911 – 4 January 1912

BAE28: Register of 1<sup>st</sup> Return Party 22 December 1911 – 26 January 1912

BAE28 (book 2): One Ton Depot Party 26 December 1911 – 21 January 1912, Observer B.C. Day

BAE30: Register of 2<sup>nd</sup> Return Party 4 January 1912 – 9 February 1912

BAE31: Dog Sledge Party, Journey to One Ton Camp 26 February 1912 – 1 April 1912. Note on front also states Autumn Relief 1912

BAE32: Log Western Journey 13 April 1912 – 23 April 1912

BAE33: Erebus 2 September 1912 – 12 December 1912, Cape Royds and Journey up Mount Erebus

BAE34: 1912 assorted 6 September 1912 – 26 September 1912

BAE35: 1912 – 1913 Dogs 14 October 1912 – 25 November 1912

BAE36: 1912 Pony II 29 October 1912 – 28 November 1912

BAE37: 1912 Pony I 31 October 1912 – 23 December 1912
