

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most places will be dry today with sunny spells, although scattered showers will develop, these becoming heavy and thundery across eastern England this afternoon. Cloud and rain will spread north-eastwards across Wales, Northern Ireland and much of England this evening and overnight, becoming heavy at times, although Scotland should remain mostly dry. Remaining very warm in central and southeast England.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain will continue across most of the country on Thursday morning, turning particularly heavy across southern and eastern parts of Britain. It will be much drier, brighter and fresher on Friday though, with a light northwesterly breeze and cooler temperatures.
