

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mainly dry and bright, with just a scattering of showers around. The showers locally heavy across northeast England this morning, otherwise generally light and fleeting. Quite warm when the sun's out, albeit with a cool breeze. Turning wet across Cornwall and Devon this evening, and other parts of southern and southwestern Britain overnight. Dry elsewhere tonight, with rural mistiness.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Cloudy, humid and wet across southern Britain on Tuesday. Brighter further north with scattered light showers. The rain spreading to Northern Ireland and northern England during the evening. Heavy showers or persistent rain Wednesday, though warm and fair in the southeast.
