Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Mainly fine, dry and warm across southeast England. Breezy with occasionally heavy rain or showers spreading northeastwards across Wales, southwest, central and northern England, Wales and into central and northern England. Scattered, heavy showers across northern parts. Tonight, further heavy rain will affect much England, Wales and southern Scotland. Mainly dry across northern Scotland, Northern Ireland and southeast England.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

On Monday, locally heavy rain over much of England, Wales and eastern Scotland will slowly clear eastwards, not leaving eastern parts until evening. Scattered showers will follow the rain, some heavy. A few light showers on Tuesday, but many places dry.
