Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many parts of the UK will be rather cloudy this morning with outbreaks of drizzle or light rain in places, most notably southeastern England and northwestern Scotland. However, most places become drier and brighter during the day and remain dry overnight with the best of any clear spells in central and eastern England.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Scattered showers for many places on Sunday, with Scotland seeing the heaviest and most frequent showers. Further outbreaks of rain or showers on Monday, although southern England may again remain dry all day. Feeling reasonably warm in the sunshine, but cooler in wetter areas.
