

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Thursday 17 Apr 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Largely dry and warm with some sunshine across southernmost parts, but becoming increasingly cloudy later. Cloud and some rain across central and northern parts gradually breaking up, with brighter, colder conditions moving southwards. Showers in the northeast in the afternoon and evening. Otherwise mainly dry overnight with clear periods. Turning chilly in the north, with a widespread grass frost likely.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday and Saturday will be dry and fine for many, with plenty of warm sunny spells and generally light winds. This will make it feel quite pleasant. It will be cloudier across northwest Scotland, though, with some rain at times.
