Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
On Monday, heavy rain in the north will spread southwards and ease, with southeast England staying dry and bright until evening. Heavy showers and stormy winds will continue across northern parts of the UK throughout the day. Strong southwesterly winds will affect most places, with gusts also reaching severe gale force across northern England.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

It will be dry and bright across much of England and Wales on Tuesday, with showers and strong winds continuing further north. Rain is expected across Northern Ireland and parts of Scotland again on Wednesday but it should stay dry with some sunshine elsewhere.
