

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloudy in northwestern parts of the UK, with persistent rain easing during the morning to leave occasional showers. The southeast should be dry, warm and mostly sunny, with more cloud in central areas. Rain will turn persistent across Northern Ireland, and much of Scotland this evening, spreading into northern England and Wales overnight. Remaining dry elsewhere.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain will move across Wales, southwest England and the Midlands on Saturday, with clearer conditions in the northwest. Sunny spells in the southeast, but with a risk of heavy, thundery showers later. Some rain will continue on Sunday, although central areas should become drier.
