Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Showery rain across southeastern Britain soon clearing away.
Scattered showers over East Anglia and northeast England, heavy
later. Most remaining parts dry with sunny periods. Rain, some heavy,
spreading across Northern Ireland during the afternoon and into
western Scotland and west Wales during the evening, continuing across
all areas overnight. Dry by dawn over Northern Ireland, Wales and
southwest England.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Rain over northern and eastern areas clearing away eastwards during
Monday morning, good sunny spells following from the west but
scattered showers in the northwest. On Tuesday, mainly dry start but
rain and strong winds spreading across western parts later.
