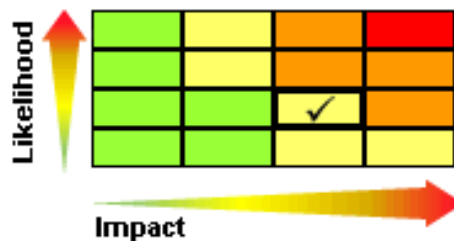
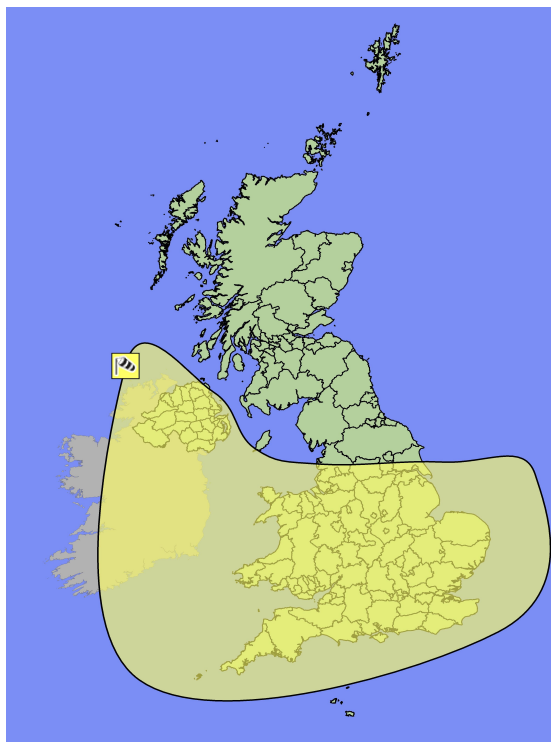




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

There is good confidence that there will be a deep area of low pressure close to the north of the country, though some uncertainty about the position and strength of the swathe of strongest winds. The public are advised to monitor this warning, which may be upgraded to amber.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Alert of Wind**

Valid from **00:00 on Tue, 13th Dec 2011** until **23:59 on Tue, 13th Dec 2011**

The very windy spell is expected to continue, with the potential for severe gales or storm force winds across the southern half of the UK and Northern Ireland. There will also be frequent, heavy showers, which bringing the risk of surface water flooding.
